But all interested people can embroider at home and thus participate in peace embroidery.




The exhibition of the submitted embroideries will take place in the cultural place Kulturort Garnlager in Lyssach, from 25 October - 15 November 2020.

Size:

The original drafts are drawn in approx. A3 size, i.e. approx. 30 x 40 cm. But you can determine the size of your embroidery yourself. It can be easily changed with the copy machine. The designs can also be downloaded and printed out individually from www.zsag.ch.

Transferring a working drawing to light-coloured fabric:

Attach the working drawing printed out in the desired size to a window with adhesive tape. Also staple the fabric over it and carefully trace the working drawing on the fabric with a pencil.

Transferring the working drawing to dark fabric:

Use tailor's copy paper that turns white on the underside. Place the paper on the fabric with the side that is rubbing off downwards and then place the working drawing on top of it in paper. Fix everything well so that nothing slips. Now trace the lines with a hard pen.

Tip:

You can also add appliqués to the embroidery and thus obtain more intense colours.

Participation in the exhibition:

Seam the finished embroidery, steam it on a soft base on the back and send it in by **18 October 2020**:

Important:

Please write your name and address on the back of the embroidery! If the embroidery is returned by post, please enclose a self-addressed and stamped envelope. (only in Switzerland)

Exhibition:

The exhibition of the finished peace embroideries will take place from 25 October - 15 November 2020. You are cordially invited to the vernissage on Sunday, 25 October 2020 at 2 p.m.!
